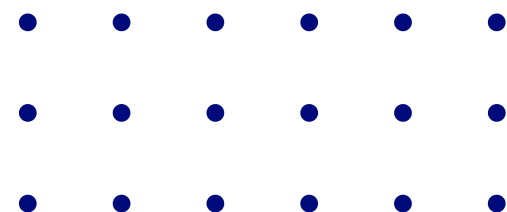
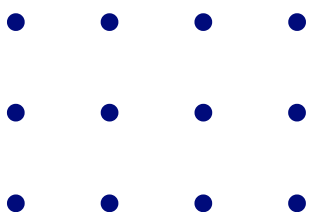

An overview of a country's Tender Market at a glance

A quick yet effective way to understand how the **Pharma Tendering Market** behaves across countries.





Sweden is divided into 21 regional councils such as Stockholm, Uppsala, Götaland, Skane etc.

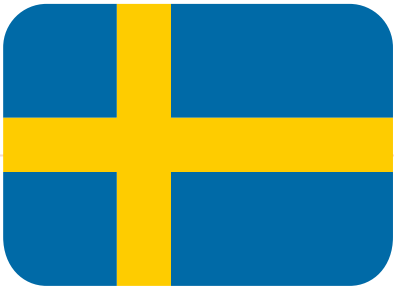
Public procurement of medicines is carried out by the councils and **the main procurement mechanism is tendering.**

Price is an important award criteria, especially for generics, but **qualitative & environmental** criteria are also considered.

Sweden is completely **liberalized** when it comes to fully-owned pharmacy chains.

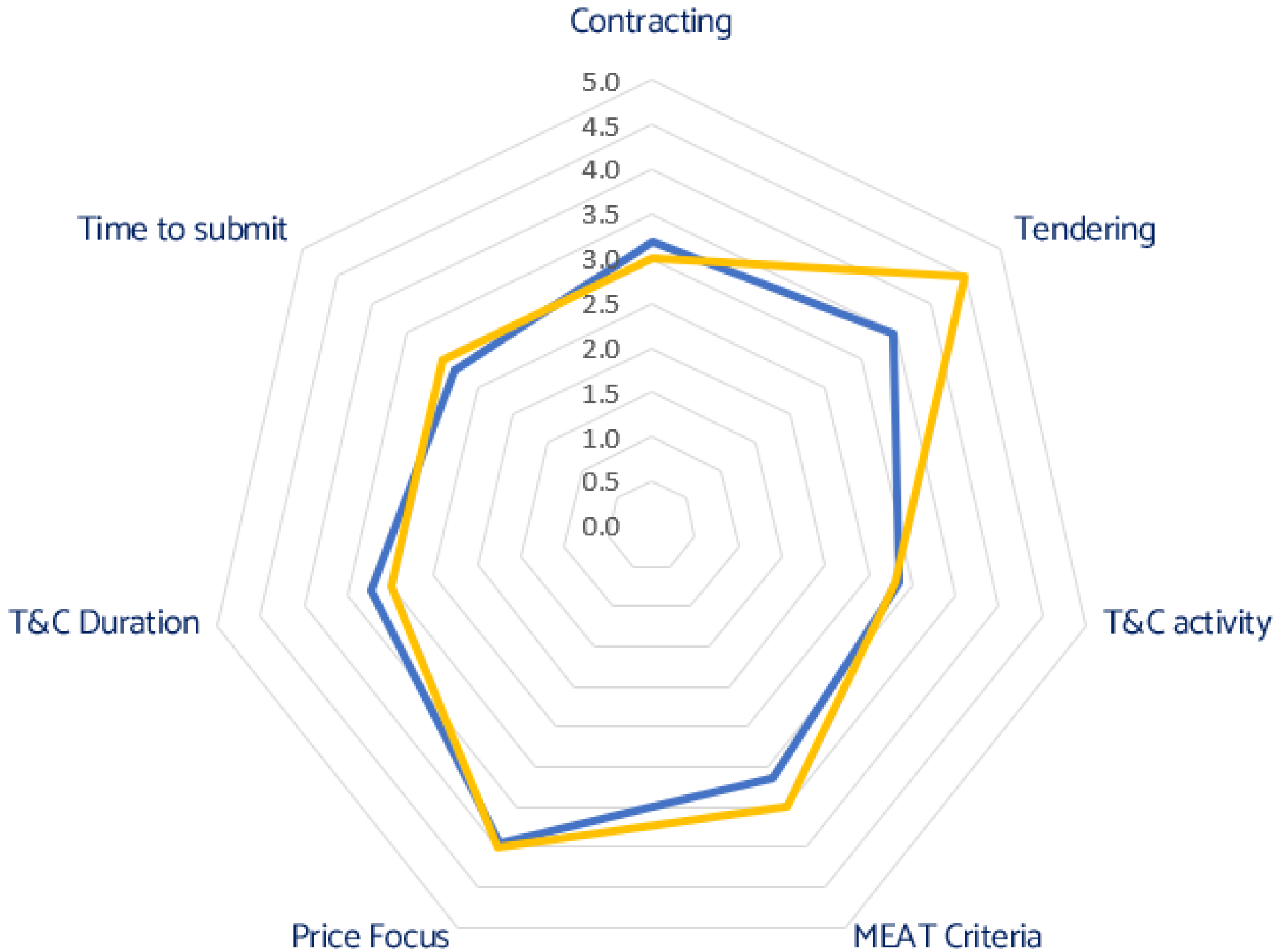
Big chains such as Apoteket AB, Apotek Hjärtat, Kronas Apotek, are applying **T&C** in their procurement of medicines.

Sources & Graph Explanation

The 'spider-net' indicates the relative importance or length (in the case of 'tender duration' and 'time to submit') of the country in-scope, versus a European average.

The spider-net is based partly on publicly available data, partly on market expert interviews and partly on growpal and CubeRM tender market know-how. It is an indication and estimate without a claim of full completeness and accuracy and it can vary - even within a country - based on tender authority, region or product portfolio.

Spider-net dimensions: 'Contracting' indicates the relative level of importance for contracting & negotiations / 'Tendering' indicates the relative level of tendering importance / 'Tender activity' indicates the number of annual tenders / 'MEAT criteria' indicates the relative importance of non-price award criteria / 'Price focus' indicates the relative importance of price / 'tender duration' indicates the average length of the tender duration / 'time to submit' indicates how much time on average a pharma-company has time to submit a tender.
